In this month of May, we also launched the CALL FOR THE VIRTUAL WORLD ASSEMBLY 2021, one of the central events of our Organization. With the experience of virtuality in 2020 and in face-to-face Assemblies around the world (which we hope can be resumed as soon as possible), the EXCO and we designed a journey that opens with an Extraordinary Session, on Saturday, June 19. Then the Regional Assemblies will follow, and the closing will be all together again in the Virtual World Assembly on Saturday, August 28. From 17 to 19 May 2021, UNESCO held a successful **GLOBAL CONFERENCE ON EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT** virtually from Berlin, in cooperation with the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research and with the support of the German Commission for the UNESCO. More than 80 ministers and vice ministers and 2,800 stakeholders in education and the environment pledged to take concrete steps to transform learning for the survival of our planet, through the adoption of the Berlin Declaration on Education for Sustainable Development (EDS) at the conclusion of a three-day virtual World Conference, followed online by more than 20,000 viewers on YouTube: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=P7WgHKmvweE</u>

The UNESCO Conference on Education for Sustainable Development concluded with the **Berlin Declaration on Education for Sustainable Development**, which outlines a series of policies to transform learning encompassing teaching, learning, professional training and civic engagement. It also highlights the need to apply ESD with a joint emphasis on cognitive skills, social and emotional learning and action skills.
