Dear colleagues,

This is the last Newsletter for 2021 and gathers news and activities for **November** and the first half of **December**.

Incredibly, we are already concluding another year marked by the pandemic, but with a lot of activity for OMEP.

At this stage we continue to strengthen ties with other organizations, we advance in the realization of our projects, new initiatives arose in different committees around the world, we participate in development processes and the signing of political declarations, we consolidate alliances with strategic actors for the realization of our goals and to face new projects. This was made possible by the joint effort of the OMEP community. Without a doubt, the pandemic limited us in many of the actions and activities to which we were used (and that we miss), but, in turn, it forced us to be creative and take advantage of all available resources to continue our advocacy work and pedagogical development for early childhood education and care, through innovative channels.

I want to take the opportunity of this latest newsletter to reflect on the **commitment** of all the members of our community, especially the EXCO members and the National Presidents, with the **communication of OMEP's global and regional activities.** In this sense, I want to share with you my **disappointment at the results achieved.**

During the month of November we have carried out two Seminars of the OMEP Seminar Series: "Education for Sustainable Development in early childhood" with the ESD World team and "What is happening with ECCE in the world?", with the Right to Education Initiative (RTE) and UNESCO. If we analyze our statistics, the ESD seminar was seen live by only 83 people, while it was watched by around 550 people recorded. The Seminar on the situation of early childhood in the world, was seen live only by 38 people and in delayed it obtained 185 views. This is high-quality content that strengthens our advocacy actions, gives a boost to education for sustainable development, and also makes us visible throughout the ECCE-related community. These seminars offered in 3 languages the videos available for later were and are use https://www.youtube.com/c/OMEPworldtv and yet they have not been leveraged hard enough.

The same occurs with the dissemination of our publications on Facebook, Instagram, YouTube or Linkedin, which although they have a high impact, **have reached "a ceiling"** that could be overcome with basic actions such as putting "likes" and sharing the posts .

Likewise, **this internal Newsletter is not shared by the Presidents of many National Committees**, so its members do not know the dimension, the content, or the meaning of OMEP's current work. This reduces the visibility and interest of new members, particularly young people.

Let us think that the great value of OMEP is directly linked to the fact that it is an **international organization specifically dedicated to ECC**E and with special consultative status at the United Nations. By sharing ideas we have the opportunity to build common approaches, to know in an updated way what is happening in the organization and in the ECCE field and to show the involvement and participation that OMEP is having in world forums. This guarantees us recognition as academic and political referents at the national and regional level and makes our advocacy for children's rights more effective.

OMEP's authority and visibility requires active internal and external communication.

Another useful strategy will be to include in your signatures and official communications the address of the **world website** <u>www.omepworld.org</u>, as well as to keep your data updated (the file has been sent by mail and very few committees have returned it complete. Please see detail at the end of the Newsletter).

In the second part of this editorial I want to **share the joy for the achievements** of the last 45 days and briefly highlight the importance of the some events and participations of OMEP:

One of the important political advocacy processes is related to the participation of the OMEP World President in the **Coordinating Group** of the **Collective Consultation of NGOs on Education 2030 (CCNGO / ED2030)** that is articulated with the work of **UNESCO**. After two years in office, I have been re-elected for the new term 2022/23 from among the members of international NGOs with official representation in UNESCO.

Likewise, the 10th was held virtually. World Meeting of the **Collective Consultation of NGOs / Education 2030 "The role of NGOs in the Global Cooperation for Education"**, on December 14, where OMEP participated both in the organization and in the list of speakers of this important session.

Also on Monday, December 6, UNESCO, EDCAN and OMEP launched the document of the **Global Partnership Strategy for early childhood** <u>https://unesdoc.unesco.org/ark:/48223/pf0000380077</u>, which constitutes a foundational milestone in the inter-agency and inter-sectoral work to be carried out as of 2022. We recommend reading the document and we ask that you complete and promote adherence through the online form:

Finally I inform you that our permanent representative in UNESCO, Lisbeth Gouin participated in the **XII International NGO Forum in official association with UNESCO "Achieving world citizenship"**, held in Paris, on December 6 and 7. In her presentation, she highlighted the importance of developing eco-citizenship from an early age, through scientific education and the development of reasoning and critical thinking from an early age. <u>http://www.ngo-unesco.net/forum_global_citizenship.html</u>

Closing this newsletter, I remind you that we are organizing the **WORLD ASSEMBLY AND CONFERENCE 2022**. The call for presentations, papers and Symposia has been extended until January 10, 2022. We are also evaluating the possibility of holding the event in a hybrid format, to ensure the widest possible participation, taking into account the uncertainty of the current and future epidemiological outlook.
