OMEP'S ACTIONS REGARDING THE WAR

OMEP continues working to **DEMAND URGENT PEACE**, **DISARMAMENT AND DIALOGUE**. We have recently signed an important joint statement (which we hope you have disseminated and shared) in alliance with the following organizations: the Early Childhood Development Action Network (ECDAN), the Early Childhood Peace Consortium (ECPC), Moving Minds Alliance, the International Step by Step Association (ISSA), the Asia-Pacific Regional Network for Early Childhood (ARNEC), the Africa Early Childhood Network (AfECN) and the Arab Network for Early Childhood Development (ANECD). The colleagues from OMEP Slovakia informed that they have spent time in a humanitarian refugee camp near the border as volunteers just after the outbreak of the war. Kindergartens have also welcomed many children, creating new and peaceful environments for all children to receive education and grow up in a healthy psychosocial environment, with excellent, caring and kind teachers. OMEP Slovakia has created a design for T-shirts that they are selling to help OMEP Ukraine. A student created a second design that will be available for free to any country that sells T-shirts to support children in Ukraine.

Safeguarding young children impacted by the current crisis and prioritizing their survival, development, and protection is not only necessary to alleviate suffering and uphold their rights, but will also drive economic recovery and build a strong foundation for peace and security, resilience, social justice, and social cohesion.

2. WORLD CONFERENCE ON EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND EDUCATION (WCECCE)

OMEP is participating in the Consultative Council of this important event organized by UNESCO. This is a category III conference, that is to say, high-ranking representatives of the States will participate. The Conference will bring together approximately 1,500 participants and will be based on four objectives and five themes:

- **a.** Creating a balance between Member States' progress towards achieving target 4.2 and other SDG targets related to early childhood.
- **b.** Exchanging knowledge on key enablers, emerging research results, good practices, and innovations to implement and improve quality ECCE policies and programs.
- **c.** Reaffirm quality ECCE as a right of all children and as the essential foundation for lifelong learning and socio-cognitive development.
- **d.** Identify opportunities, develop and agree on a set of priorities and strategies to accelerate progress on SDG 4.2 and increase investment in ECCE by governments and their partners.
