## EU-SELF

OMEP has been invited to support a Erasmus + project Social and Emotional Skills Development in Early Childhood Education and Care in Europe- EU-SELF. With partners in Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Portugal and Sweden, the project aims are: - to link the knowledge and practice of early childhood SES development and - to develop a SES information hub for Europe (web-based digital platform), where this information will be available, so all stakeholders (early childhood specialists and practitioners, teachers, educators, parents, researchers, decision-making bodies, national and/or local authorities, ECEC providers, EU bodies, etc.) can benefit from it. https://eu-self.nbu.bg/en

Research shows that if children are not attaining minimal social and emotional skills (SES) at around six years of age, they are likely to be at risk in the next stages of their development. Well-developed SES in children contribute to academic success, improve learning conditions, and are a powerful tool for empowering children for a better future, for a happier and more productive life, but also they are an irreplaceable tool for prevention of social exclusion, aggression and bullying, school dropout, different types of risk behaviours, etc.

Two overviews will be produced, and this is where OMEP may become helpful:

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### First ever Virtual European Regional Assembly

We made it! On September 30, 42 delegates, observers and guests representing 23 National OMEP committees met for a Virtual Regional Assembly.

I sincerely thank all participants for your enthusiastic and friendly presence.

We were greeted by World President Mercedes Mayol Lassalle, World Treasurer Elin Eriksen Ödegaard, and OMEP Representative in UNESCO Lisbeth Gouin, thank you all! We also managed to vote by using the possibilities in the ZOOM meeting.

After a rather formal beginning – this was after all a Regional Assembly – we had time to break up the meeting into eight different groups of 3-6 members each. During some 45 minutes, delegates and observers had the chance to meet and discuss OMEP, what is happening in the different countries, and what should be done.

The World Assembly, on November 28, 2020, was announced and Effrosyni Katsikonouri, president of OMEP Greece, updated us on the OMEP WA & WC in Athens in July 2021. We also had time for some delegates to address some other business.

# the Czech Republic

#### **Concerning coronavirus situation**

Kindergartens have not been closed officially in the Czech Republic due to ministerial order. But most of founders (local authorities) closed kindergartens from March 16 to May 25. After this date, most of kindergartens were open again in emergency regime which meant only limited opening hours, no access of parents and other people, compulsory use of masks for teachers, disinfection of a place, and so on. The Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Public Health provided kindergartens with recommendations concerning it.

During kindergarten closure, parents and other guardians (e.g. grandparents) had to take responsibility for their children care. They were supported financially – they received the childcare allowances.

During emergency regime, some kindergartens were asked to provide care for children of so called "workers in the first line" (medical doctors, policemen, firemen, soldiers) by the Czech government and local authorities

From July 2020, kindergartens were open again and started to function in regular regime.

#### **Concerning OMEP CR activities**

Due to coronavirus situation we were not able to organize the annual meeting which was scheduled for March 2020. We have planned to postpone it for the autumn. However, the current Covid 19 situation has made us to decide not to organize it. Instead, all necessary documents have been sent to the OMEP members with a request to vote on them per rollam. We communicate with our members via web side, Facebook and e-mails.

We have concentrated our effort to a careful preparation of the project and national competition on ESD (Evaluation Scale - Preschool education for sustainable development) which is now ready to be open. We plan to open it in mid-October. In connection with the ESD project and competition, we planned to organize the national conference in the autumn 2020. However, also this one has to be rescheduled for the autumn 2021.

At the end of 2019, OMEP Czech had 115 individual members and 4 collective members.

It should be mentioned that the whole 2020 has been very difficult due to corona restrictions not only for preschool education and OMEP in the Czech Republic.

## France

#### Pandemic Corona

Preschools and Nurseries closed on 19 March 2020, only children of health care workers and teachers in care grouped in voluntary schools; partial opening on 22 June; Full opening on 2 September, new class closures if 3 positive cases.

ECE teachers work during the Corona: reaching families; remote work adapted when connection is possible and sufficient and suitable equipment.

During confinement, children aged 0 to 6 are mainly dependent on families, with distance or adapted education follow-up, a lot of screen time. Parents may not be able to help children and do not have to replace teachers.

Material problems: Inadequate, unsuitable and often discriminatory.

Teachers with little training and/or underperforming, unprepared for socio-emotional aspects ; but creativity and commitment on their part.

When the kindergartens are reopened: lightening of sanitary measures, barrier gestures maintained, distance 1m where possible, no masks for children under 11 years old (no free masks) ; closed classes from 3 positive cases.

National reports on improvements, problems or abuse of children: reports and documents being written and/or analyzed.

**INITIATIVES of OMEP-France during Corona**: sending a Covid questionnaire, answers being analysed; returning all information in direct communication to our members and on our website.

**OMEP Projects**: See Global Report 2019; participation in UNCR projects, updated takeover from 2019 to 2020 and Color your rights.

Ideas to increase OMEP's finance : Change the statutes to have a World Assembly one year out of 2 (biennial), alternating with the Regional Assembly ; Assembly and World Conference alternating virtual and present (biennial), as in 2020 /2021 ; Take into account the number of members, for example increments of 0-100, 100 -500, more than 1000... ; Find sponsors.

furniture are fully completed, 103 children aged 3 to 6 attend school regularly.

- ESD: Communication of the ESD OMEP Global project to the French National Commission for UNESCO ; Teacher training on ESD and the SDGs in Paris

Participation in International Days: PEACE : Songs/Chorales for Peace ; 30 th anniversary of the UNCRC : 6 actions (workshops, events, meetings and debates).

# Ireland

Corona pandemic: All Early Childhood Care and Education (ECEC) setting closed in March

The importance of ECEC in society has become very apparent over the last number of months in Ireland. An announcement was made March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020 by the Taoiseach Leo Varadkar TD of the closure of ECEC and schools, to support efforts to contain the spread of Covid-19. This was in line with the advice of the National Public Health Emergency Team.

ECEC facilities opened to all parents who needed childcare in order to return to work from 29 June, subject to capacity. In the Government's roadmap for reopening the country, this was originally limited to essential workers. However, Department of Children and Youth Affairs quickly saw the importance of ECEC provision and confirmed that this was been expanded to all those in need of childcare. OMEP Ireland clearly believes that we need strong and objective voices with international backing to remind our government and policy makers that things need to transform within the state for all our children and their families.

#### **OMEP Ireland Projects**

• The 2019 OMEP Ireland Annual Research Conference took place on Saturday, 9th November 2019 at Cork Institute of Technology, Ireland. The Conference Theme for the 2019 conference was 'Relationship Matters & What Matters in Early Years Relationships'. We were delighted to have received an overwhelming number of abstracts. PLE Ireland also launched their Professional practice guidelines at our conference while we also presented the first OMEP student of the year award.

• An Leanbh Óg (The Young Child): OMEP Ireland published An Leanbh Óg vol 13 in August 2020. The editors for 2020 were Dr. Frances Clerkin, Dr Vanessa Murphy and Dr Judith Butler & and will continue for 2021 for vol 14 which will be published in May 2020. 1 We made the e-book version free online during these unprecedented times.

• OMEP Ireland Student of the year award: OMEP Ireland wished to recognise the work of students undertaking study in early childhood care and education in Ireland by presenting the 'OMEP EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AWARD' to the top graduates in this field in Ireland. College/ university lectures were invited by letter to select one piece of work from their highest achieving student from 2018/19 to go forward for this award. The work (e.g. essay, dissertation, project or other) is assessed by a team of OMEP academics and the winner was presented with their award at our National Conference in November 2019 at Cork Institute of Technology. The interest in this award was great and we hope to continue going forward • Celebration of special days (International Day of peace, WASH from the start, ESD project, Play and

resilience day). We disseminate information to our members regarding these special events via email, social media and going forward on the new blog.

#### OMEP Ireland Blog

In 2019 we launched our OMEP Ireland Blog in order to improve communication with our members. Going forward we will publish thoughtful, creative and exciting research, and opinion-based posts on early childhood education and care from interested parties. # Italy

The Italian Preparatory Committee is at the end of its path **towards formalization as a National Committee**. If in the first year of work, we have mainly committed ourselves to recovering a history of the presence of

the Organization in our country and to participating in events and initiatives, regional and global, in this second year we have instead concentrated on building relationships with the institutional and most relevant realities that have an interest in the issues of early childhood education and care and for sustainable development in our country.

In this period of constant work, we have therefore strengthened mutual relationships in order to create meaningful contacts - of exchange and collaboration - with the realities that could benefit from the contribution of the Organization for its competence in the field of preschool education. We have also worked to ensure that the debate on early childhood education could also go beyond the traditional areas of discussion and invade multiple contexts of social life.

This intention has also been implemented for communication purposes, that is to promote OMEP on a national and global level. We have verified that OMEP is a reality whose proposal, due to its history and mission, can be accepted as authoritative and important, not only by professionals in the specific field, but in the general public debate. Currently, OMEP in Italy is, in fact, finally perceived as an organization operating and existing in our country: a reality with which one can collaborate in the long term and which leads significant battles in favor of children's rights.

**Italy was the first Western country to operate a total lockdown due to COVID-19**: which provided for the closure of all educational and school services. For about six months, the activities did not resume. The Italian Preparatory Committee, which in the spring of this year had set a series of events in the presence, throughout the national territory and which would continue until the autumn, for the official presentation of OMEP in Italy, had to review its agenda and transfer the activities to other platforms.

In reality, the long period of the health emergency has been characterized in Italy as a profound questioning of previous certainties: as in a sort of year zero, our country has experienced a reconsideration of many issues related to civil life and for the unity of the national community. The theme of childhood and its rights, which was in danger of being overlooked, was instead strongly re-proposed, although not immediately. We took advantage of this unexpected and alienating time to imagine a new normality, also as an actual and contextualized new action, for OMEP in Italy.

Now, we look at the World Assembly, which will be held in a special way in November, for the formal presentation of the new Committee in the concrete synthesis of all that we have collected so far.

Identified problems?

• Preschool teachers must pay attention to children's well-being and take care of children's thoughts and reflections on C19.

Improvements? What did the children do during Corona?

•The children work, play and so on as usual. If given the opportunity, many children have expressed their thoughts through creative materials and conversations.

Purpose: To spread knowledge about how OMEP's scale for sustainable development can be used in practice. Pilot project together with preschools

• "Add color to the Convention on the Rights of the Child", the Convention on the Rights of the Child in pictures

The purpose is to disseminate knowledge to preschools about the meaning of the Convention on the Rights of the Child

• The well-being of the youngest children - About the importance of potty/toilet training at home and preschool

Background: Reports from child health care testify that more and more children suffer from constipation with subsequent ailments. One reason for this may be that many children are not potty/toilet-trained but are referred to the use of diapers up to the age of four.

Purpose: The purpose of this project is to make parents and preschool staff aware of the importance of children's potty/toilet training in collaboration with the child health service

#### World Special days

•The purpose of this project is to disseminate information about the specific days that are set up to remind of specific anniversaries with children's health and well-being in focus. The plan is to create an annual calendar where current days are marked. The calendar will be distributed to preschools and interested parties.

Ideas for increasing the OMEP finances

• How should the money be used; this is a primary question.

• Increased marketing, arrange conferences, clarify the aim and work of the OMEP organization, make OMEP more familiar,

#### Other OMEP initiatives during 2020:

# Turkey

#### WHAT DOES PRE-SCHOOL TEACHERS THINK ABOUT DISTANCE EDUCATION?

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Distance education generally refers to the education that takes place when students and teachers are physically located in separate settings. Distance education is a modern and innovative education system where live, video, and audio lessons are taught in a fully virtual environment, people can watch and view them again whenever they want, and education and training pass through the computer environment with today's technology. With the pandemic restrictions, distance education has become even more important. Especially due to the pandemic, it is seen that the distance education process is on the agenda at every level of education. However, this situation brought many questions that need to be questioned. In this context, this study aimed to determine the opinions and experiences of preschool teachers on distance education in early childhood education. In this study, it is planned to use the mixed method research design in which quantitative and qualitative data are used together. In this context, the research will be conducted with the basic design of Convergent Design, one of the mixed method research designs. Within the scope of the research, an online questionnaire with 31 questions was created, which is planned to be delivered to pre-school teachers online. In the quantitative phase of the research, it is aimed to collect data through this questionnaire (Demographic information, do you think that all children have equal access to the distance education process implemented in your country?, Which of the following distance education applications did you use in this process?, Did you carry out a study with the families during the distance education process you did? etc.). In the qualitative aspect of the research, semi-structured interviews are planned with 10 volunteer teachers. The stages planned within the scope of this research are as follows:

- 1. Finalizing the questionnaire items,
- 2. Determining the participating countries,
- 3. Translation of the questionnaire into the language of the country,
- 4. Testing the cultural compatibility of the questionnaire,
- 5. Obtaining the necessary legal permissions,
- 6. Application of the survey to the sample group determined throughout the country,
- 7. Implementation between September and November 2020,
- 8. Evaluating the survey application processes on a day determined by video conference,
- 9. To ensure that the report prepared on the basis of the country is published as a chapter book.
