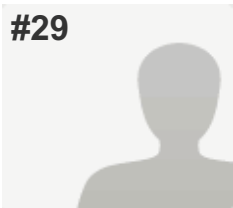

In Slovakia, the issue of hand washing, teeth, face, belongs to the basic hygiene practices that are part of the environment of kindergarten daily fine. Children learn in partnership with parents to follow these important hygiene habits, but also for hand washing, using the toilet, save water and keep drinking regime. The 1st of March is the Day of Water. During this period, primarily, but also throughout the school year, kindergarten have developed internal projects and activities which through games, creative drama, theater, poems and songs for children approaching the need to conserve water and wash hands. In kindergartens there is a common to use toilets for girls and boys, but in some kindergartens already appear divided. In primary and secondary schools are particularly toilets for girls and boys.
