Dear colleagues,

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the birth of the prestigious pedagogue Paulo Freire. For this reason, governments and NGOs that share his values and ideals have honored him with commemorations around the world. At OMEP, we held the second seminar of the OMEP Seminar Series 2021-2022 called: **100 years Paulo Freire: 1921-2021. Pedagogy as a political practice.** The presentations were made by Ph.D Carlos Calvo from Chile and Ph.D. Roberto Mauro Gurgel Rocha from Brazil -both of whom knew Paulo Freire personally- and me, while OMEP's Regional Vice President for Latin America, Desireé López de Maturana Luna, moderated the seminar.

As we stated in the title, pedagogy is a political practice. This conviction was stated by Paulo Freire and shared with other intellectuals and educators around the world through his intense praxis and his extensive work. This is recognized around the globe and transcends its literacy method to become a political, pedagogical, ethical and aesthetic proposal of education, clearly current, and that helps us to address the challenges of our present time. Paulo Freire's humanist thought continues to support our positions because it is based on ethics, critical thinking, the defense of democracy, participation and a pedagogy of hope that posits trust in the possibility of all human beings to learn and to change the world. The foundational ideals of OMEP include the fundamental elements put forward in Paulo Freire's proposals, such as participation, communication, humanization, transformation and contextualization.
